Dear Sirs,

Reference is made to your letter, dated 12 November 2009, concerning claims for compensation for personal injury allegedly caused by lead contamination in certain camps for Internally Displaced Persons in Mitrovica, Kosovo.

In your letter, you repeat your offer to meet with me to discuss your clients' claims. As I explained to you, in my letter dated 30 October 2009, the complexity of this matter requires careful and detailed review by the United Nations Office of Legal Affairs in consultation with UNMIK. That office is working on the matter in coordination with UNMIK's Office of Legal Affairs. At this time it would not be useful for me to meet with you personally to discuss the case. However, I will ask UNMIK's Office of Legal Affairs to establish communications with you, with the aim to revert to you in due course regarding your clients' claims.
